Super7 Golf Association takes great pride in the image we would like to convey at all our tournaments, family functions, fundraisers and other social events.

In order to maintain an atmosphere or professionalism and respect, we ask that the following code of conduct be adhered to as follows:

Players, guest and visitors are all subject to the Code of Conduct.

Violations of the Code of Conduct will result in disciplinary actions by the Super7 Golf association board.

- 1. Unsportsmanlike like conduct; including.
 - -Abusive language
 - -Club throwing

-Showing disrespect to other player, paying patrons of the tournaments site or social event.

-Abuse, vandalism, to the golf course, or event location.

-Disruptive behaviour, (yelling, screaming etc.)

- 2. Intentionally engaging in criminal activity
- 3. Engaging in activities that are potentially dangerous to others.
- 4. Intentionally violating course rules (local rules) or facility rules.
- 5. Intentionally providing in-accurate scores or score card (handicapping purposes).
- 6. Continually misses scheduled tee times or misses event altogether without formal communication.

The following penalties will/maybe applied if a player, guests are in violation.

- A severe reprimand
- Request to leave the event (visitors).
- Severe violations may result in disqualification and forfeiture of entry fees.
- 1-2 stroke penalties on the day of the event.
- Other penalties will be determined by the Super7 Golf association committee.
